RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ADVANCEMENT AND DEVELOPMENT OF AVIATION, MAKING THE GENERAL EDWARD LAWRENCE LOGAN AIRPORT SELF-SUPPORTING, AND CERTAIN RELATED MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to
2 consist of two members of the senate to be designated
3 by the president thereof, three members of the house
4 of representatives to be designated by the speaker
5 thereof, and two persons to be appointed by the
6 governor, is hereby established for the purpose of
7 making an investigation and study of the subject
8 matter of current house document numbered two
9 hundred and thirty-four, providing for the advance-
10 ment of aviation by reduction of noise from aircraft
11 motor exhausts, propellers and air friction; current
12 house document numbered two hundred and thirty-
13 five, providing for the advancement of aviation by
14 elimination of noise from aircraft motor exhausts,
15 propeller and air friction; current house document
16 numbered two hundred and thirty-six, providing for
17 an investigation and study by an unpaid special
18 commission relative to the problem of reduction of
19 noises caused by aircraft motors, exhaust gases,
20 propellers and air friction and for the greater develop-
21 ment of aviation within this commonwealth; current

22 house document numbered ten hundred and twenty
23 relative to making the General Edward Lawrence
24 Logan airport at East Boston self-supporting; current
25 house document numbered twelve hundred and sixty,
26 providing for an investigation and study by an unpaid
27 special commission relative to the problem of reduc-
28 tion of noises caused by aircraft motors, exhaust
29 gases, propellers and air friction and for the greater
30 development of aviation within this commonwealth;
31 and Appendix H of current house document numbered
32 eighteen hundred and twelve, providing for a study
33 by a special commission relative to aeronautics and
34 aviation, and to consider such other matters related
35 to the development of air navigation facilities in the
36 commonwealth as it may deem advisable. Said com-
37 mission shall be provided with quarters in the state
38 house or elsewhere, may travel within or without the
39 commonwealth, and may expend for travel and other
40 expenses, and for clerical and other assistance, such
41 sums as may hereafter be appropriated therefor.
42 Said commission shall report to the general court the
43 results of its investigation and study, and its recom-
44 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
45 necessary to carry said recommendations into effect,
46 by filing the same with the clerk of the senate on or
47 before the first day of February in the year nineteen
48 hundred and forty-eight.
