AN ACT TERMINATING THE AUTHORITY OF THE PAROLE BOARD TO GRANT CERTAIN SPECIAL PERMITS TO BE AT LIBERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and twenty-
2 two of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-three is
3 hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. Nothing in this act shall be deemed to
2 affect the validity, legality or effectiveness of any
3 special permit heretofore granted under said chapter
4 two hundred and twenty-two.
