AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COSTS OF EXAMINATION OF CREDIT UNIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 171 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph,
3 as appearing in chapter 323 of the acts of 1936, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following: —

5 To defray in part the expenses of each regular
6 examination of a credit union provided for by section
7 two of chapter one hundred and sixty-seven, each
8 credit union so examined shall pay a fee of thirty
9 cents per each one thousand dollars of its assets as
10 shown by its statement of condition on the date of
11 such examination, which fee shall in no event be less
12 than fifteen dollars. Such fees shall be payable
13 within thirty days after notice from the commissioner,
14 but no fee shall be collected hereunder from a credit
15 union until it has been in operation for a period of
16 one year.
