Accompanying the sixteenth recommendation of the Commissioner of Corporations and Taxation (House, No. 50). The Judiciary.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT REQUIRING COPY OF THE ORDER REQUIRED TO BE DELIVERED TO THE COMMISSIONER OF CORPORATIONS AND TAXATION IN CONNECTION WITH THE SERVICE OF PROCESS UPON CERTAIN DOMESTIC CORPORATIONS TO BE IN DUPLICATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 37 of chapter 223 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 306 of the acts of
3 1945, is hereby further amended by inserting in the
4 fourth sentence of the last paragraph, after the word
5 "order", the words:— in duplicate, — so that said
6 sentence shall read as follows:— The party making
7 such application shall deliver a copy of such order in
8 duplicate with a fee of two dollars to the commis-
9 sioner of corporations and taxation, or his deputy or
10 second deputy, when acting under section six of
11 chapter fourteen, or in the office of said commissioner.

The Constitution of the State

Article I. Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.

Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be admitted into or excluded from this Union according to their respective Numbers, which shall be determined by adding to the whole Number of free Persons, including those bound to Service for a Year or more, and excluding Indians not taxed, three fifths of all other Persons.

But no Representative shall hold a Seat longer than seven Years, and no Person shall be Representative who shall not, when elected, have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, and seven Years shall have elapsed since the emigration of such Person from the Territory from which he shall be so elected. The Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.
