MASSACHUSETTS AERONAUTICS COMMISSION,
LOGAN AIRPORT, EAST BOSTON 28, December 3, 1947.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives.

GENTLEMEN: — In accordance with the provisions of chapter 30, section 33, of the General Laws, as amended, I am submitting herewith drafts of bills embodying the legislation recommended by the Massachusetts Aeronautics Commission. The purpose of these bills is as follows:

1. To authorize the inspectors of the Aeronautics Commission to exercise whatever police power is necessary to enforce the Aeronautical Laws and Regulations.

2. To permit certain employees of the Commonwealth Airport at Bedford to exercise sufficient police power to enforce the State's regulations on the airport.

3. To permit the Commission to dispose of surplus property at the Bedford Airport.

4. To permit the Commission to enter into short temporary lease agreements for rights and concessions at the Bedford Airport.

5. To remove the statutory limitation on the salary of the Bedford Airport manager.

6. To continue the Commonwealth's participation in the construction and improvement of municipal airports.
