AN ACT ESTABLISHING FEES FOR PHYSICIANS AUTHORIZED TO MAKE PHYSICAL AND MENTAL EXAMINATIONS OF CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 58A of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 616 of the acts of
3 1947, is hereby further amended by adding at the end
4 the following sentence:— The fee for each physician
5 making an authorized mental and physical examina-
6 tion hereunder shall be seven dollars, and twenty
7 cents for each mile traveled one way. The expense
8 of such examination shall be paid by the county
9 within which the judicial district of such court is
10 located, and shall be repaid to such county paying
11 them by the county, if any, of which the child is an
12 inhabitant, in the same manner as provided in section
13 seventy-four of chapter one hundred and twenty-
14 three.
