By Mr. Donlan of Boston, petition of Edmond J. Donlan for legislation to establish the salary of the justice of the municipal court of the West Roxbury district. The Judiciary.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE DISTRICT OF WEST ROXBURY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 76 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 576 of the acts of
3 1947, is hereby further amended by inserting after
4 the word "dollars", in the eleventh line, the words:
5 —, the salary of the justice of the municipal court
6 of the district of West Roxbury shall be seventy-two
7 hundred dollars, — so as to read as follows: — *Section*
8 *76.* The salary of the justice of the Boston juvenile
9 court shall be six thousand dollars, and that of the
10 clerk of said court an amount equal to seventy-five
11 per cent of the salary of the justice. The salary of
12 the justice of the East Boston district court shall be
13 fifty-six hundred dollars, the salary of the justice of
14 the municipal court of the South Boston district shall

15 be fifty-six hundred dollars, the salary of the justice
16 of the municipal court of the Brighton district shall be
17 fifty-six hundred dollars, the salary of the justice of
18 the municipal court of the Charlestown district shall
19 be fifty-six hundred dollars, the salary of the justice
20 of the municipal court of the district of West Rox-
21 bury shall be seventy-two hundred dollars and the
22 salary of the justice of the district court of Chelsea
23 shall be fifty-two hundred dollars. The salaries of
24 the justices of the following district courts shall sev-
25 erally be as follows: First district court of Barnstable,
26 twenty-seven hundred dollars; second district court
27 of Essex, twenty-four hundred dollars; second dis-
28 trict court of Plymouth, thirty-two hundred dollars;
29 third district court of Plymouth, twenty-five hundred
30 dollars; fourth district court of Plymouth, twenty-
31 five hundred dollars; district court of Peabody, three
32 thousand dollars; district court of eastern Hamp-
33 shire, twenty-one hundred dollars; district court of
34 Newburyport, three thousand dollars.
