AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRUSTEE PROCESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 32 of chapter 246 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out paragraph 8th, in-
3 serted by chapter 343 of the acts of 1938, and insert-
4 ing in place thereof the following:—

5 Eighth, By reason of money or credits due for the
6 wages of personal labor or services of the defendant,
7 unless such attachment is made in an action brought
8 upon a judgment recovered in any court of the com-
9 monwealth.
