By Mr. Ralph W. Sullivan of Boston, petition of Ralph W. Sullivan that concessions for the operation in public buildings of stands for the sale of commodities be granted only to disabled war veterans. Military Affairs and Public Safety.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CONCESSIONS FOR THE OPERATION
IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS OF STANDS FOR THE SALE OF COM-
MODITIES SHALL BE GRANTED ONLY TO DISABLED WAR
VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 A concession for the operation in any public build-
2 ing of a stand for the sale of newspapers, magazines,
3 cigars, cigarettes, tobacco, confectionery and refresh-
4 ments, or any of such commodities, shall be granted
5 only to a veteran, as such term is defined in section
6 twenty-one of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws,
7 who comes within the class referred to as disabled
8 veterans in section twenty-three of said chapter thirty
9 one. Whoever violates this section shall be punishe
10 by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars.
