AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT IN PART OF
LOSSES IN TAXES ON PROPERTY TO THE TOWN OF LENOX
BY REASON OF ITS USE FOR CHARITABLE, EDUCATIONAL,
SCIENTIFIC OR RELIGIOUS PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The commonwealth shall annually reimburse the
2 town of Lenox by an amount equal to two thirds of
3 the last taxes assessed and payable in said town upon
4 such parcels therein now exempt from taxation by
5 reason of their use for charitable, educational, scien-
6 tific or religious purposes.
