By Mr. Mulligan of Boston, petition of Edward J. Mulligan that telephone companies be required to furnish their subscribers with itemized statements of charges for unit messages, so called. Power and Light.

AN ACT REQUIRING TELEPHONE COMPANIES TO FURNISH THEIR SUBSCRIBERS WITH ITEMIZED STATEMENTS OF CHARGES FOR UNIT MESSAGES, SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 166 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 15A, inserted by chapter
3 242 of the acts of 1935, the following new section: —
4 *Section 15B.* The bills of a telephone company
5 which include charges for unit messages, so called,
6 shall contain an itemized list of such charges.
