AN ACT REQUIRING THE REMOVAL OF CERTAIN SMOKE AND ASH NUISANCES IN SOUTH BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Boston Elevated Railway Company and the
2 Boston Edison Company are hereby directed forth-
3 with to abate and remove, or cause the abatement
4 and removal of, all smoke and ash nuisances now
5 respectively maintained, or caused or allowed to be
6 maintained, by them in that part of the city of Boston
7 commonly known as South Boston.
