By Mr. Gray of Springfield, petition of Thomas T. Gray for legislation relative to the cancellation of compulsory motor vehicle liability insurance policies. Insurance.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CANCELLATION OF INSURANCE POLICIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No refusal to review a compulsory
2 motor vehicle liability insurance policy shall become
3 effective until the person aggrieved shall have had an
4 opportunity to appear before the board of appeal on
5 motor vehicle liability policies and bonds. The appeal
6 board shall give each such person at least twenty-days
7 notice of a hearing.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage
2 notwithstanding any law or laws to the contrary.
