AN ACT INCREASING THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS SERVING IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any provision in any general or special law to the
2 contrary notwithstanding, the retirement allowances
3 of officers serving in the department of correction
4 shall be not less than one half of the compensation
5 received by them at the time of their retirement after
6 fifteen years of service, not less than two thirds of
7 such compensation at the time of their retirement
8 after twenty years of service and not less than three
9 fourths of such compensation at the time of their
10 retirement after twenty-five years of service.
