The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO SELL A PART OR PARTS OF THE VINCENT CUTTILLO PLAYGROUND IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary pro-
2 visions of general or special law, the city of Boston,
3 by its mayor, with the assent of the Park Commis-
4 sioners may sell at public auction or private sale any
5 part or parts of that portion of land taken by eminent
6 domain by the board of street commissioners of said
7 city on the twenty-sixth day of March in the year
8 nineteen hundred and seventeen, as evidenced by the
9 instrument recorded with Suffolk Deeds, Book 4020,
10 page 271, which is still held by said city for public
11 park purposes.

1 SECTION 2. The mayor of said city shall, in the
2 name and on behalf of said city, execute and deliver

3 any instrument necessary to convey any land sold
4 under this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
