By Mr. Jenness of Quincy, petition of William W. Jenness that the Port of Boston Authority be authorized to construct shore protection in the city of Quincy. Harbors and Public Lands.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE PORT OF BOSTON AUTHORITY OF SHORE PROTECTION IN THE CITY OF QUINCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Port of Boston Authority is hereby authorized
2 and directed to construct approximately thirteen
3 hundred lineal feet of granite shore protection along
4 the beach in the city of Quincy bordering Shellton
5 road from Shoreside road to Swan road. For said
6 purpose, said department (Authority) may expend
7 such sums, not exceeding, in the aggregate, fifty
8 thousand dollars, of which amount one half shall be
9 paid by the commonwealth and one half shall be
10 contributed by the city of Quincy.
