AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PORTION OF ROUTE 110, SO CALLED,
IN THE TOWN OF METHUEN, AS A STATE HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The care, control and maintenance of that portion
2 of the public highway known as route 110 which
3 lies in the town of Methuen westerly from Merrimack
4 street, in said town, is hereby transferred to and
5 placed in the department of public works, and said
6 portion of said highway shall be a state highway and
7 the care, control and maintenance thereof shall be
8 paid out of the Highway Fund.
