AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REFUSAL OR REVOCATION OF LICENSES TO THEATRICAL BOOKING AGENTS, PERSONAL AGENTS AND MANAGERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 180A of chapter 140 of the General Laws,
2 as amended by chapter 566 of the acts of 1946, is
3 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the
4 following paragraph:—

5 A license may be revoked or refused at any time
6 by the commissioner for good cause shown; pro-
7 vided, that due notice shall have been given to appear
8 before the commissioner to show cause why the
9 license should not be revoked or refused.
