AN ACT REQUIRING EMPLOYEES COVERED BY NON-CON-
TRIBUTORY PENSIONS LAWS TO JOIN THE CONTRIBUTORY
RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Any person who is an employee of the common-
2 wealth, or of any county, city, town or district, who
3 has actual or inchoate pension or retirement rights
4 under any general or special law, shall, as of January
5 first, nineteen hundred and forty-nine, become a mem-
6 ber of the contributory retirement system in effect
7 for employees thereof, and shall then and thereafter
8 be subject to all of the provisions of sections one to
9 twenty-eight, inclusive, of chapter thirty-two of the
10 General Laws. Any such person who has attained the
11 maximum age for his group on such date, or who at-
12 tains such maximum age within two years after such
13 date, shall have the same rights for continuance of
14 employment as if such date were the operative date
15 of the system.
