AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF TOWN
TREASURERS AND COLLECTORS OF TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 41 of the General
2 Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out the paragraphs contained in the 6th,
4 7th, 8th and 9th lines, as appearing in the Tercente-
5 nary Edition, and inserting in place thereof the fol-
6 lowing paragraphs:—

7 A town treasurer for the term of six or more years.

8 A collector of taxes for the term of six or more
9 years, unless the town votes to authorize its treas-
10 urer to act as collector.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall not affect the current
2 term of any person holding the office of town treas-
3 urer or of collector of taxes when this act takes effect.
