By Mr. Hurwitz of Cohasset, petition of Roy M. Cushman for legislation to establish the annual salaries of the justice and clerk of the Boston Juvenile Court. The Judiciary.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE AND CLERK OF THE BOSTON JUVENILE COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 76 of chapter 218 of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 576
3 of the acts of 1947, is hereby further amended by
4 striking out the first sentence and inserting in place
5 thereof the following: — The salary of the justice of
6 the Boston juvenile court shall be an amount equiva-
7 lent to the salary of an associate justice of the municipi-
8 pal court of the city of Boston, and that of the clerk
9 of the said Boston juvenile court an amount equiv-
10 alent to the salary of the first assistant clerks of said
11 municipal court of the city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July first
2 in the current year.
