## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT POLICE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF BOSTON SHALL BE GIVEN AN ADDITIONAL DAY OFF DUTY OR AN ADDITIONAL DAY'S PAY WHEN THEY ARE REQUIRED TO WORK ON A STATE-WIDE LEGAL HOLIDAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of  
2 section thirteen of chapter two hundred and ninety-  
3 one of the acts of nineteen hundred and six, as  
4 amended, if any police officer of the city of Boston is  
5 required to work on January first, February twenty-  
6 second, April nineteenth, May thirtieth, July fourth,  
7 the first Monday of September, October twelfth,  
8 November eleventh, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas  
9 Day, or the day following when any of the five days  
10 first mentioned, or October twelfth, November  
11 eleventh or Christmas day, occurs on Sunday, he

12 shall be given an additional day off, or, if such addi-  
13 tional day off cannot be given by reason of a personnel  
14 shortage or other cause, he shall be entitled to an  
15 additional day's pay.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon  
2 its acceptance by vote of the city council of said city,  
3 but not otherwise.
