AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE ALEWIFE FISHERY IN THE TOWN OF WEYMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of conservation is hereby author-
2 ized and directed to make such improvements at the
3 alewife fishery in the town of Weymouth as may be
4 necessary or desirable. For said purposes there may
5 be allowed and paid out of the state treasury, subject
6 to appropriation, the sum of six thousand dollars;
7 provided, that no part of said amount shall be ex-
8 pended until the town of Weymouth shall have paid
9 into the state treasury the sum of twenty-five hun-
10 dred dollars for said improvements.
