AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPENSATION OF SPECIAL JUSTICES OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON WHEN SITTING IN SAID COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 52 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting
4 in place thereof the following: — His compensation
5 for each day's service shall be equal to the per diem
6 compensation of an associate justice of the court;
7 and, except when holding an additional session as
8 above provided, the compensation for service in
9 excess of thirty days in any one year which may be
10 rendered to or for any one justice shall be deducted
11 by the treasurer of Suffolk county from the salary
12 of such justice.
