By Mr. Skerry of Medford, petition of Homer H. Swindon and others that unemployment compensation benefits be granted to persons unemployed because of vacations. Labor and Industries.

AN ACT GRANTING UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION BENEFITS TO PERSONS UNEMPLOYED BECAUSE OF VACATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 24 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, as
2 amended, is hereby further amended by the addition
3 of the following paragraph: —

4 A person who is unemployed because of a vacation
5 in the establishment where he is employed shall not
6 be rendered ineligible for benefits under this chapter,
7 notwithstanding the fact that said vacation was
8 granted as a result of agreement between the em-
9 ployer and the union of which said person is a mem-
10 ber, provided said person is not entitled to vacation
11 compensation from his employer.
