By Mr. Driscoll of Boston, petition of William H. Crowley relative to providing for the establishment of salaries of court officers in attendance upon the municipal court of the city of Boston. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SALARIES OF COURT OFFICERS IN ATTENDANCE UPON THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 218 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 chapter 486 of the acts of 1945, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out section 82A and inserting in
4 place thereof the following new section:—

5 *Section 82A.* Each officer in attendance upon the
6 municipal court of the city of Boston who is appointed
7 under section sixty-one shall receive from the county
8 of Suffolk in full for all services performed by him
9 such salary as shall be fixed by the justices of such
10 court.
