AN ACT REDUCING THE AGE REQUIREMENTS OF APPLICANTS FOR OLD AGE ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section one of chapter one
2 hundred and eighteen A of the General Laws, as
3 appearing in section one of chapter four hundred and
4 eighty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-
5 three, is hereby amended by striking out, in the second
6 and in the twelfth lines, the word "sixty-five" and
7 inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the word:
8 — sixty.
