AN ACT CHANGING THE TIME FOR THE HOLDING OF BIENNIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN THE CITY OF TAUNTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 448 of the acts of 1909 is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 1, and inserting in place
3 thereof the following section: —

4 *Section 1.* Beginning with the year nineteen hun-
5 dred and forty-nine, municipal elections in the city of
6 Taunton for the choice of mayor, members of the
7 municipal council and members of the school com-
8 mittee shall be held biennially on the Tuesday next
9 following the first Monday of November in every
10 odd numbered year.
