AN ACT PLACING THE OFFICE OF SENIOR LEGAL ASSISTANT
OF THE APPELLATE TAX BOARD UNDER THE CIVIL
SERVICE LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The office of senior legal assistant of the appellate
2 tax board shall, upon the effective date of this act,
3 become subject to the civil service laws and rules,
4 and the tenure of office of any incumbent thereof
5 shall be unlimited, subject, however, to said laws, but
6 the person holding said office immediately prior to
7 said effective date shall be subjected by the division
8 of civil service to a non-competitive qualifying exami-
9 nation, and if he passes said examination he shall be
10 certified for said office and shall be deemed to be
11 permanently appointed thereto without being required
12 to serve any probationary period.
