AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POSITION OF CHIEF OF DETECTIVES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 22 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby
3 amended by adding at the end thereof the following:
4 — Detective inspectors and supervisors in the de-
5 partment of public safety shall perform their duties
6 in the division of state police under the direction and
7 supervision of a chief of detectives, who shall be
8 subject to the provisions of chapter thirty-one and
9 who shall be appointed from among the detective
10 inspectors and supervisors of the division of state
11 police after competitive examination in accordance
12 with civil service rules.
