AN ACT EXTENDING THE BENEFITS OF THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 151A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 24, inserted by
3 section 1 of chapter 685 of the acts of 1941, the
4 following new section: —

5 *Section 24A.* Any person otherwise ineligible for
6 benefits under this chapter solely because of the
7 shortness of the duration of his employment shall be
8 eligible for such benefits if under the terms of his
9 employment he was not entitled to any vacation
10 period without loss of compensation.
