
By Mr. Diniz of New Bedford, petition of Jacinto F. Diniz that the city of New Bedford be authorized to sell lots of land for one dollar each to veterans of World War II for the purpose of building homes thereon.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD TO SELL LOTS OF LAND FOR ONE DOLLAR EACH TO VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING HOMES THEREON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of New Bedford may sell suitable lots of
2 land for the sum of one dollar for each lot to veterans
3 of World War II, who have been discharged from
4 service in the armed forces of the United States for
5 reasons other than dishonorable, for the purpose of
6 erecting homes thereon. Such lots shall be located
7 as near to highways as possible. Said city may sub-
8 divide and improve any available tract of land under
9 its control for the purposes of this act, provided, that
10 this act shall not authorize the sale of such land at less
11 than the cost thereof to said city. Such lots shall not
12 be resold by any such veteran, and if a dwelling is
13 not constructed thereon within two years from the
14 date of the sale the lot shall revert to the city.
