AN ACT LIMITING THE COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 mitted by the department of public utilities, the

4 president, vice-president or any director of any firm,
5 corporation, association or company furnishing or
6 rendering services under the supervision, regulation,
7 jurisdiction and control of said department, shall not
8 exceed ten thousand dollars.
