- 3 direction of any veteran taking advantage of the
- 4 benefits of the G. I. Bill of Rights, so called, relating
- 5 to apprentice training, or "on the job" training,
- 6 unless he is himself a veteran, nor unless his release
- 7 or discharge from the armed forces of the United
- 8 States was under conditions other than dishonorable.
