## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE POLICE COMMISSIONER OF BOSTON BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The governor of the commonwealth of Massachu-

4 appointee has been and is a resident, taxpayer and
