## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE POLICE COMMISSIONER FOR THE CITY OF BOSTON BY THE MAYOR OF SAID CITY, AND RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFICATIONS OF SAID COMMISSIONER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of  
2 chapter two hundred and ninety-one of the acts of  
3 nineteen hundred and six, as amended, the mayor of  
4 the city of Boston shall appoint and may remove the  
5 police commissioner for said city, and such commis-  
6 sioner shall be a resident, voter and taxpayer of said  
7 city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon the  
2 expiration of the term of office of the present police  
3 commissioner for the city of Boston.
