## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE OR MORE AIRPLANES FOR THE EXTINGUISHMENT OF FOREST AND BRUSH FIRES IN THE COMMONWEALTH UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Funds shall be provided, not in excess of
- 2 dollars for the purchase of one or more airplanes to

- 4 conservation for the extinguishment of forest and
- 5 brush fires in the commonwealth.
