### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPENSATION OF VETERANS EMPLOYED BY COUNTIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of sections forty-  
2 nine to fifty-six of chapter thirty-five of the General  
3 Laws or of any rule or regulation made thereunder,  
4 any veteran, as such term is defined by section twenty-  
5 one of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws, who  
6 now is or hereafter may be employed by any county  
7 shall attain the maximum salary of the office, position  
8 or grade in which he is employed upon completing  
9 two years of service in such office, position or grade.
