AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR AN UNDERGROUND TUNNEL FROM
HAYMARKET SQUARE, BOSTON, TO BELLINGHAM SQUARE,
CHELSEA.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 A commission of five members shall be appointed
2 by the governor to formulate plans for the building
3 of an underground tunnel, to be paid for by toll
4 charges from Haymarket square, Boston, to Belling-
5 ham square, Chelsea.
