AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF STATE ARMORIES FOR SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE BURIAL OF THE BODIES OF CERTAIN VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any armory under the supervision and control of
2 the armory commission may be used for the con-
3 ducting of appropriate funeral and other services held
4 in connection with the burial of the body of any
5 veteran who died overseas during World War II, so
