### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISCHARGE OF CERTAIN PATIENTS AT THE SOLDIERS' HOME IN CHELSEA.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Unless otherwise specifically requested by him, no
- 2 veteran admitted to the soldiers' home in Chelsea for
- 3 surgical or operative treatment shall be discharged
- 4 therefrom for a period of at least ten days following
- 5 the last such treatment there given him.
