

HOUSE No. 1057

By Mr. O'Neill of Cambridge, petition of the Federation of State, City and Town Employees for the payment of annuities to dependents of laborers, mechanics, craftsmen and foremen in the public service who are killed or have died from injuries received or hazards undergone in the performance of duty. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF ANNUITIES TO DEPENDENTS OF LABORERS, MECHANICS, CRAFTSMEN AND FOREMEN IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE WHO ARE KILLED OR HAVE DIED FROM INJURIES RECEIVED OR HAZARDS UNDERGONE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF DUTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The provisions of section eighty-nine of chapter
2 thirty-two of the General Laws, providing for the
3 payment of annuities to dependents of certain public
4 employees who are killed or have died from injuries
5 received or hazards undergone in the performance of
6 duty, are hereby extended to and shall hereafter ap-
7 ply to cases of deaths of laborers, mechanics, crafts-
8 men and foremen in the public service.
