AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE AND ASSIST THE EXPANSION OF
SMALL BUSINESS IN THE FIELD OF SMALL GAS APPLI-
ANCES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 No public utility corporation engaged in the manu-
2 facture and sale, at wholesale or retail, of artificial
3 gas for the purposes of heating and illumination shall
4 be allowed to engage in the business of selling at
5 retail small gas appliances for use in refrigeration,
6 cleaning, cooking, heating or lighting.
