

By Mr. Kamens of Chelsea, petition of the Massachusetts State Pharmaceutical Association relative to changing the powers and duties of the agents of the Board of Registration in Pharmacy. Public Health.

AN ACT CHANGING THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE AGENTS OF THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION IN PHARMACY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 25 of chapter 13 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 6 of chapter 596
3 of the acts of 1941, is hereby amended by striking out
4 said section 25 and inserting in place thereof the fol-
5 lowing section:—

6 *Section 25.* The board shall appoint not more than
7 four agents who shall be allowed necessary traveling
8 expenses. They shall inspect drug stores and all
9 other places of business wherein drugs, medicines,
10 patent medicines, medical preparations and medical
11 supplies of any kind are sold or distributed, and shall
12 make a report of their doings pertaining thereto to
13 the board, and shall report all violations of the laws
14 relating to pharmacy and the retail drug business and
15 all violations of the rules and regulations of the board.
16 As directed by the board, they shall file criminal
17 complaints against all violators of such laws, rules or
18 regulations.
