AN ACT GRANTING CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS FROM TAXATION TO VETERANS OF WORLD WAR I AND WORLD WAR II.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause 22 of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General
2 Laws, as amended by chapter 627 of the acts of 1945,
3 and as amended by chapter 579 of the acts of 1946,
4 is hereby further amended by inserting at the end of
5 paragraph (c) the words: — this shall also include the
6 widows of men who lost their lives in the service of
7 their country.
