RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO ENACT THE TAFT-ELLANDER-WAGNER BILL, SO CALLED, FACILITATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF HOUSING FOR VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II AND OTHERS.

1 *Resolved*, That the general court of Massachusetts
2 memorializes the Congress of the United States to
3 enact into law the Taft-Ellander-Wagner bill, so
4 called, facilitating the construction of housing for
5 veterans of World War II and others, as provided
6 therein; and be it further

7 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be trans-
8 mitted forthwith by the state secretary to the presi-
9 dent of the United States, to the presiding officers of
10 each branch of Congress, and to the members thereof
11 from this commonwealth.
