By Mr. Chadwick of Winchester, petition of Theodore L. Storer that the location of the Massachusetts Maritime Academy be changed to the state pier on Cape Cod Canal and authorizing the board of commissioners of said academy to acquire property adjoining said pier. Education.

AN ACT CHANGING THE LOCATION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS MARITIME ACADEMY TO THE STATE PIER ON THE CAPE COD CANAL, PLACING IN THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SAID ACADEMY THE CONTROL OF SAID PIER, AND AUTHORIZING SAID BOARD TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY ADJOINING SAID PIER FOR THE PURPOSES OF SAID ACADEMY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of commissioners of the
2 Massachusetts Maritime Academy is hereby au-
3 thorized to change the location of said academy from
4 the property formerly used for the purposes of the
5 state teachers college at Barnstable to the state pier
6 on the Cape Cod canal in Buzzards bay. Said board,
7 upon effecting said change of location, shall have con-
8 trol of said state pier property which shall be used
9 by said board in carrying out the duties imposed
10 upon it by law.

1 SECTION 2. Said board, on behalf of the common-
2 wealth, may take by eminent domain, or acquire by
3 purchase or otherwise, so much of the property ad-
4 joining said state pier property as may be approved
5 by the governor and council. The property acquired
6 under the authority of this section shall also be under
7 the control of said board and shall be used for drill,
8 athletic and other purposes of said academy.

1 SECTION 3. Chapters three hundred and forty-
2 seven and five hundred and nineteen of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and forty-six are hereby repealed.
