AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM COMPENSATION OF THE TEACHERS IN THE PUBLIC DAY SCHOOLS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The compensation of every teacher employed in
- 2 any public day school, except persons in training or
- 3 temporary substitutes, shall be at the rate of not less
- 4 than twenty-four hundred dollars for the school year.
