

HOUSE No. 1237

By Mr. Brennan of Boston, petition of Jeremiah F. Brennan that the Mystic River Bridge Authority be prevented from authorizing the destruction or impairment of buildings used for family dwelling purposes until occupants thereof have found other suitable dwelling places and relative to the paying of compensation for parks and playgrounds taken by said authority. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWERS OF THE MYSTIC RIVER BRIDGE AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Mystic river bridge authority,
2 established by section three of chapter five hundred
3 and sixty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred and
4 forty-six, in connection with the performance of the
5 duties or the exercise of any authority conferred upon
6 it, shall not permit or authorize the destruction or im-
7 pairment of any building used for family dwelling
8 purposes until the occupants thereof have found other
9 dwelling places or until the authority shall have found
10 comparable dwelling places for said occupants.

1 SECTION 2. Said authority shall pay compensation
2 to the city of Boston for any public park or playground

3 taken by it. Such compensation shall be used by
4 said city only for the purpose of providing public
5 parks or playgrounds to replace those so taken. Such
6 compensation may be recovered by said city under
7 chapter seventy-nine of the General Laws.
