AN ACT REPEALING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF LAW RELATIVE TO THE FEES FOR THE ENTRY OF CERTAIN ACTIONS IN WHICH PERSONS NOT CLAIMING JOINTLY HAVE JOINED AS PARTIES PLAINTIFF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section four A of chapter two hundred and thirty-
2 one of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
3 out the second sentence which was inserted by section
4 one of chapter four hundred and eight of the acts of
5 nineteen hundred and forty-seven.
